



Location Scout Guide

Try visiting your location about a week before you are hoping to film, ideally at the same time of day your filming will take place. You can write down your answers to questions below for your future reference. Take pictures if possible.

Travel

- a. how long does it take to get to your location?
- b. How will you access the location at the time of shooting? Do you need special permission or access?

Visuals

- a. What is the best time of day for optimal light?
- b. Can you turn lights on and off, are there blinds or window to control daylight?
- c. Is there an interesting background?

Sound

- a. Close your eyes. What does it sound like?
- b. Will time of day impact noise level when you are filming?
- c. Is this location accessible to the public? Can you control if people enter location?

Technical

- a. Are there power outlets in case you need to recharge batteries and run lights?
